4	(10+) GAME DAY PRE-GAME TEAM MEAL	(5+) Parents are needed to pick up food from local restaurants and serve meals on varsity game days in the 8/9 cafeteria, Fridays 1:30-3:30 PM. <i>Food and drinks will be paid for out of the Player Meal Fees.</i>
5	(10+) GAME DAY POST-GAME MEALS	(2-4) Parents are needed to hand out Gatorade, Wawa shorties and a bag of chips to players immediately following the game. At home , this will be done outside of the locker room on the sidewalk. At away games you will need to park near the player buses. You will pick up the drinks (BJs), hoagies (Wawa RT 340), pack in coolers with ice and transport to game. You will need either two cars to transport food/drinks or 1 pickup truck. 2-3 large coolers. <i>Food and drinks will be paid for out of the Player Meal Fees.</i>
