	Freshman Parent Responsibility	Details
1	FRESHMAN BOOSTER CLUB LIAISON & SOCIAL MEDIA MANAGER	Primary liaison between freshman parents, coaches and varsity booster club <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to communicate key football information to parents & players (TeamSnap/Social Media) - Coordinate parents to bring food to Freshman assigned team dinners - Solicit volunteers for various duties throughout season - Post updates to Freshman Facebook and Instagram Accounts - First stop for questions + provide guidance related to the football program. The varsity booster club is here to assist you when needed.
2	GATORADE DONATION – 1 CASE PER PLAYER 24 pk./20 fl. oz. WATER DONATION – 1 CASE PER PLAYER 24 pk./20 fl. oz.	Collected at 1 st team meeting (usually after the start of school) Label with player's last name. Will be used on game days. Must be stored at one of the team parent or coaches house.
3	TEAM DINNERS GREAT FOR TEAM BUILDING AND TO GET TO KNOW OTHER PARENTS.	2 team dinners hosted by Freshman parents in the school 8/9 cafeteria <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ex: pasta/meatballs, pizza, hoagie trays etc. - Signup Genius sent to freshman parents to sign up to bring food, drinks, desserts and assist with serving/cleanup. - Or ask a local business to donate a meal.
4	GAME DAY DRINK / SOFT PRETZELS	1 freshman parent per game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Home Games: 2 cases of Gatorade per game (from supply) - Away Games: purchase soft pretzels (paid by your Fundraiser or money collection), 2 cases of Gatorade, 2 cases of water from booster club supply - Distribute Gatorade to players/coaches prior to game. - Distribute water to players/coaches after games with snack.
5	HOME VARSITY GAME NIGHT (FRIDAYS) Parents will receive free entry to the game on nights you are assigned to work.	6 freshman parents per game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - (4) Sell spirit wear at table in stadium 5PM - end of halftime. - (2) Handle program money collected at the gates 5PM - end of 1st quarter and then help at spirit wear table until end of halftime. - After halftime, merchandise must be packed up and locked in ticket booth.
6	\$230 TEAM CAMP FEE Players attending camp will receive a camp swag pack that includes a team T-shirt & shorts compliments of the booster club	Team Camp will be held at Millersville University July 7/21 -7/23 Transportation will NOT be provided. Please make carpooling arrangements in advance. Players are not permitted to drive themselves per Millersville camp rules. Camp attendance is mandatory, but strongly encouraged.

2	Home Varsity Game Night (Fridays) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All freshman football players receive free home game season pass courtesy of the football booster club 	4 freshman players and 2 parents per game: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sell game programs at the home side gates (2). 5PM - End of 1st Quarter. - Each player is required to work one game. Signup Genius will be sent out to sign up.
